Notice Regarding Final Decision of CCS Litigation Case for Design Infringement

Kyoto, Japan, 20 July 2020 – CCS Inc. (CCS; Headquarters: Kyoto, Japan; President - Hiroyuki Onishi) has won a design right infringement lawsuit in Japan against Leimac Ltd. (Leimac; Former Company Name: IMAC Co., Ltd., Headquarters: Moriyama City, Shiga Prefecture, Representative Director, Mamoru Tanaka).

CCS sought action based on infringement of design rights held for the heat radiation fin of its HLV Series spot lights (Japanese Design Registration No. 1224615). Its victory was officially confirmed after the Supreme Court rejected Leimac's appeal of the Osaka High Court's decision. The lawsuit against Leimac for patent infringement remains ongoing.

CCS will continue to take resolute action for infringement of intellectual property rights where appropriate and necessary as part of its ongoing efforts to contribute to the development of the image processing inspection industry.
