Schedule change for the UKCA marking added to products

2. What's new?


We informed you in June 2021 that CE-compliant products manufactured from **1 October 2021** would include a new UKCA marking. However, upon the new business guidance published by the British Government on 24 August, we have decided to change our schedules and response to compliance as below.

3. Details of the new UKCA guidance

The deadline to apply the UKCA marking has been postponed for a year.

The new deadline is 1 January, 2023, rather than 1 January, 2022.

This extension means all goods which previously required the CE markings will not need to use the UKCA marking until 1 January 2023. Also a transition period allowed for 2022 has been removed.



4. Details of our compliance

The UKCA marking will be affixed directly to products (or to the product packaging if necessary) from 1 October 2021 onward.

For products with designs that cannot accommodate a UKCA marking, the marking is affixed on packaging.

*2 Effective dates depending on products. Products shipped after the effective date may or may not have the UKCA marking.
